Fidelity Investments plans \$100 million N.C. facility

RALEIGH, N.C. Fidelity Investments plans to spend 100 (m) million dollars to build a new facility in North Carolina.

Governor Mike Easley says the facility in Wake County will employ about two-thousand workers.

Boston-based Fidelity is the nation's largest mutual fund company.

It's not immediately clear if the North Carolina jobs are new positions, or would move from another of Fidelity's locations.
