Texas-based Total Facility Solutions expanding in Raleigh, creating 50 new jobs

A Texas subcontracting company has opened an office in Raleigh and expects to hire about 50 workers over the next year.

Total Facility Solutions of Plano, Texas, specializes in construction contracting services installing high-purity piping, gas and chemical systems, tool and equipment installation and electrical services for the semiconductor, life sciences, data centers and renewable energy industries.

It has leased 6,400 square feet in a building at Brier Creek in west Raleigh that will serve as the company's focal point for its life sciences facilities contracting service division and will be the company's regional hub for its existing renewable energy and technology business throughout the Southeast region. The facility also has a 4,000-square-foot fabrication shop equipped with orbital welding equipment.

TFS President Joe Cestari expects to hire about 50 employees in the first year with expansion expected over the long term. "It is a great time to lay more solid foundations in the region," Cestari said in a statement. "You only have to look at the companies that have already located here in recent times as well as the work being undertaken at places like the Golden Leaf B-TEC Center and N.C. Solar Center to realize that this is a region full of development potential."
